

By Proclamation and right as Absolute Empress 12 of all Montana, I bring forth the following Proclamation:

Let it be known from this day forward, September 15, 2007, that Based upon the need of education and lack of in state resources available for members of the Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender and straight allied communities in the State of Montana, I now add a new resource to our community by introducing and implementing the Imperial Sovereign Court of the State Montana Rosalinda de la Luna Scholarship.

The scholarship program is created to assist and help those GLBT community members and straight allies who are residents of the State of Montana seeking higher education and to assist and help to provide a foundation for those in need of economic resources to launch their academic careers.

A minimum of 2 scholarships with a minimum amount of \$500 per scholarship shall be awarded to GLBT individuals and straight allies who strongly support the GLBT community of Montana. These applicants must be residents of the State of Montana seeking higher education from an accredited higher education institution. Students must enroll or be enrolled full time, 12 credits or more, to be eligible.

Recipients of the awards will be required to present a 2 to 4 minute speech at the ISCSM Coronation event where the award of the scholarship is to be officially presented.

In helping to achieve the goals of the scholarship fund, all proceeds from a minimum of one ISCSM sanctioned event are to directly benefit the ISCSM Rosalinda de la Luna Scholarship. All funds earmarked for the scholarship fund are to be used only for the scholarship fund.

The Scholarship Review Committee shall select awards for the scholarships by means of reaching consensus for applications and criteria. The criteria for scholarships will be outlined in the policies and procedures of the ISCSM. The Scholarship Review Committee shall consist of members of the Board of Directors and professionals of the GLBT and straight allied community of Montana.

Policies and procedures will be created to administer this scholarship and should be reviewed annually to best meet the needs of this scholarship and the community of Montana.
